



Gold Hill Hookers 2024



We are excited to announce the Gold Hill Hookers 2024 crappie fishing tournament trail. This is a crappie **club** with a rich history of comradery, mentoring, and competition – meaning it is not open to the public and requires a current or past member to invite new anglers. If you have friends, family, or otherwise interested in crappie fishing – this is the club for them to get started. *NOTE* - I posted the club rules below. I will entertain comments from club members regarding rules. If you do not pay a membership fee, then you are not a member and I am not going to entertain or consider comments.

Tournament dates:

March 23, 2024 (\$50 entry)
March 30, 2024 (\$50 entry)
April 13, 2024 (\$50 entry)
April, 27, 2024 (\$50 entry)
May 4, 2024 (\$50 entry)
May 18, 2024 - CLASSIC- (\$100 entry)

Check in will be from 5:30am until 6:15am on tournament dates at boat ramp designated on Friday night social media post.

Must be in weigh-in line within 1 hour from tournament ending. (2pm in line by 3pm, 1:30pm in line by 2:30pm). No exceptions.

Entry fee for regular season tournament is \$50.00 with \$10 being taken out for the big fish pot. Payout will be based on \$40 remaining dollars. Entry fee for Classic is \$100.00 with optional \$10 big fish side pot. **Membership fee is \$25.00 per angler (children 12 and under are free and do not count as 1 of 2 fisherman in the boat).**

\$20 big fish of the year side pot is optional. Must be paid prior to tournament to be eligible to weigh big fish of the year. In the event of a tie, side pot will be split between both anglers.

In the event of a tie during a tournament, tie breaker will be big fish weighed.

2 people per boat, 12-rod limit, 2 baits per rod, 7-fish **ALIVE** limit, no restrictions on electronics.

Must pay for 4 regular season tournaments to qualify for Classic.

Payout will be top 3 places. 20% will be held for the Classic purse. Classic will pay 100% of all funds remaining (20% of purses held throughout season and excess membership fees).
